

ORDINANCE NO. 806

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF ONE NEW VEHICLE FOR THE CANBY POLICE DEPARTMENT AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City is desirous of purchasing one new vehicle for use by the Municipal Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the State of Oregon Purchasing Division can purchase one new Chevrolet vehicle at a reduced price of \$11,184.75, on behalf of the City of Canby; and

WHEREAS, ORS 279.015 (1)(a) exempts from competitive bidding, contracts to purchase from other public agencies, such as the State of Oregon, now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf an appropriate contract for the purchase of one new Chevrolet vehicle for the purchase price of \$11,184.75, to be purchased through the State of Oregon Purchasing Division.

Section 2. In order to put this car into service with the Canby Police Department as soon as possible, to benefit all the citizens of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon final reading and action by the Canby City Council.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, July 1, 1987; ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for a

second reading and action of the City Council at a regular meeting thereof to be held on July 15, 1987, after the hour of 7:30 o'clock p.m., at the Council meeting chambers at the Canby City Hall, Canby, Oregon.
