

**ORDINANCE NO. 964**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH NORTHSIDE FORD TRUCK SALES, INC. FOR THE LEASE/PURCHASE OF A NEW 66,000 GVW CAB AND CHASSIS WITH DROP AXLE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for a lease/purchase contract for a new 66,000 GVW cab and chassis with drop axle; and

**WHEREAS**, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Oregonian on Friday December 13, 1996 and Monday December 16, 1996 and in the Daily Journal of Commerce on the same dates; and

**WHEREAS**, bids were received and opened on December 31, 1996 at 10:03 A.M. by the Wastewater Treatment Facility Supervisor, Steve Hanson for the City of Canby and the following responses were read aloud:

**WHEREAS**, one other bid was received from Portland Freightliner, but said bid was rejected because it didn't comply with the chassis specs required and because of the 90 day delivery date; and

**WHEREAS**, the Canby City Council, acting in its capacity as Contract Review Board, met on January 15, 1996, and considered the bids and reports and recommendations of the City staff, including the staff recommendation that the low responsive bid be selected; and

**WHEREAS**, the Canby City Council determined that the low responsive bid was that of Northside Ford; now therefore,


**THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an

appropriate contract with Northside Ford Truck Sales, Inc., for the lease/purchase of a 66,000 GVW cab and chassis with drop axle for a total purchase price not to exceed \$76,586.27.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby to immediately provide for the replacement of the old truck which is in danger of failure, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.


