

ORDINANCE NO. 810

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER FOR THE CITY OF CANBY, COUNTY OF CLACKAMAS, OREGON, TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES IN CONNECTION WITH THE CONSTRUCTION OF STREET IMPROVEMENTS IN THE PUBLIC RIGHT -OF- WAY OF SOUTH FIR STREET AND A PORTION OF SOUTHWEST FOURTH AVENUE LOCATED IN CANBY, OREGON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby intends to construct street improvements in the public right-of-way of South Fir Street and a portion of Southwest Fourth Avenue, including surfacing, curb, sidewalk and utilities as required; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to employ an engineer to perform various engineering services for the design and construction of said improvements; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Curran-McLeod, Inc., Consulting Engineers of Tigard, Oregon, is the engineering firm they desire to provide such service; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute, and deliver in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Curran-McLeod, Inc., for services in connection with the street improvements of South Fir Street and a portion of Southwest Fourth Avenue in Canby, Oregon. A copy of said contract is attached hereto marked as Exhibit "A".

Section 2. An emergency is hereby declared to exist in order that the required engineering work can be started and completed as soon as possible to benefit the citizens of the City of Canby and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on September 2, 1987; ordered posted as required by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading on Wednesday, September 16, 1987, commencing after the hour of 7:30 p.m., at the Council Meeting Chambers at the Canby Public Library in Canby, Oregon.
