## ORDINANCE NO. 831

AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SERVICES OF CITY COUNCILPERSONS AND MAYOR AND REPEALING ORDINANCES NO. 594 AND 693.

## THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The duly elected and qualified Mayor for the City of Canby shall be paid from funds of the City budgeted for such purposes the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month, and each duly elected and qualified Councilperson shall also be paid from said funds the sum of Forty-five Dollars (\$45.00) per month.

Section 2. The payments to be made to the Mayor and Councilperson as authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall commence July 1, 1989, and continue thereafter until changed by ordinance. Such payments shall be made monthly in the regular

course of business and no further order, authorization or approval for such payments shall be required.

Section 3. Neither the Mayor any Councilperson shall be paid for attendance at any committee meeting or other meeting of the City's officials except as noted in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 594 enacted September 29, 1975 and Ordinance No. 693 enacted February 18, 1981 are hereby repealed.
