ORDINANCE NO. 849

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PARKER-NORTHWEST PAVING COMPANY FOR THE OVERLAY OF N. MANZANITA STREET FROM N.E. 10TH TO N.E. 16TH AVENUES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore sought bids for the overlay of N. Manzanita Street from N.E. 10th Avenue to N.E. 16th Avenue; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on October 3, 1990; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on October 10, 1990, at 2:00 p.m. by the Public Works Director, Wayne Klem, in the Canby City Hall and the following bid was read aloud:

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Parker-Northwest Paving Comapny, Oregon City, Oregon, for the overlay street project on N. Manzanita from N.E. 10th to N.E. 16th Avenues to the published specifications, for the bid amount of \$34,991.00. A copy of said contract is attached hereto, marked as Exhibit "A" and by this reference is incorporated herein.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon, to complete this overlay project as soon as possible in order to better serve the citizens of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take affect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
