## ORDINANCE NO. 850

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 16.880.030 OF THE CANBY MUNICIPAL CODE, SETTING APPLICATION FEES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

Section 1. Section 16.88.030 Applications and Fees is amended to read:

Applications for annexations, zone changes, variances, conditional use permits, design review, appeals, other permits or approvals and property divisions initiated by property owners or their agents shall be made in writing and submitted to the City Planner. Each application shall be accompanied by a fee. Said fees shall be set out by resolution approved by the City Council. Fees shall differentiate between various processes and applications and no part of which shall be refunded.

Section 2. Table 16.88.030 and the footnote is deleted in its entirety.

Section 3. In order to immediately promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Canby by determining fees to be set by resolution, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall be effective upon its final passage by the City Council.
