

ORDINANCE NO 851

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING MUNICIPAL CODE SECTION 13.24.070 TO BE CONSISTENT WITH MANDATES FROM THE ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the Environmental protection Agency has promulgated rules to enforce the Clean Water Act; and

WHEREAS, the rules stipulate that cities are to develop sewer use ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the rules further stipulate that the ordinances must contain a monetary fine for violating the ordinance of at least one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Municipal Code Section 13.24.070 (A) is hereby amend to read:

A. Any person that fails to comply with or shall violate any of the provision of these rules and regulations shall be deemed guilty of a violation and, upon conviction thereof, shall be fined in an amount not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00).

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Canby for health, safety and general welfare, this ordinance shall take effect immediately after final reading and enactment by the Canby City Council.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 7, 1990, ordered posted as provided by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading and action of the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 21, 1990, commencing at the hour of 7:30 p.m., in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
