ORDINANCE NO. 871

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 6.04, TITLED ANIMALS GENERALLY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, it has been determined by the Canby City Council that present "special permits" for keeping of certain non-domestic animals in the City limits of Canby should be an administrative decision.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> Section 6.04.030 Special Permits shall be amended to read as follows:

"Special permits for the keeping of other than domestic pets may be granted administratively by the City Administrator on such terms and conditions and for such periods of time as may be determined by the Administrator. Application for such permits shall be filed with the City Administrator for review and determination. A decision of the administrator allowing a permit may be appealed to the City Council. The Council may hold a public hearing on the appeal after notice of the hearing is given in the usual manner provided for public hearings."

<u>Section 2.</u> Emergency Clause. In order to better promote the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Canby an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
