ORDINANCE NO. 901

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CANBY MUNICIPAL CODE 6.08 REGARDING ANIMAL NUISANCE AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Canby Municipal Code Section 6.08 is amended by adding section 6.08.045, to read:

Section 6.08.045. Offensive Littering by an Animal

Any person in control of an animal which defecates on the property of another without permission of the property owner, upon any public way as defined in ORS 164..805 (2), or upon public parks property, commits the offense of permitting offensive littering by an animal if said person fails to promptly remove and properly dispose of the animal waste.

Section 2. In order to better protect the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Canby, an emergency is declare to exist and this Ordinance shall become effective on the final reading.
