

ORDINANCE NO. 933

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH COURTESY FORD, PORTLAND, OREGON, FOR A 1995 ONE AND ONE-HALF TON UTILITY TRUCK; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has budgeted funds for a one and one-half ton utility truck for the Sewage Treatment Plant use; and

WHEREAS, the purchase will be made in compliance with ORS 279.015 (1)(g) A utilizing an existing solicitation for the City of Portland under Portland Fleet Services Bid # 95242-C; and


WHEREAS, Courtesy Ford of Portland, Oregon, submitted the low bid for 1995 Ford one and one-half ton utility trucks to the City of Portland, now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Courtesy Ford, Portland, Oregon, for a 1995 Ford One and One-half Ton Utility Truck for the bid amount of \$28,751.50

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon, to complete this project as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting therefore on Wednesday, April 5, 1995; ordered posted as required by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading on Wednesday, April 19, 1995, after the hour of 7:30 p.m. at the Council Chambers at the Canby City Hall, 182 N. Holly, Canby, Oregon.
