AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH BRAD'S COTTAGE GROVE CHEVROLET, COTTAGE GROVE, OREGON, FOR THREE (3) CHEVROLET CAPRICE POLICE CARS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has budgeted funds for a three (3) police cars for use by the Canby Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the purchase will be made in compliance with ORS 279.015 (1)(g) A utilizing an existing solicitation for the State of Oregon under State of Oregon Contract Release Order # 135768; and

WHEREAS, Brad's Cottage Grove Chevrolet at Cottage Grove, Oregon, submitted the low bid for Chevrolet Caprice police cars to the State of Oregon, now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Brad's Cottage Grove Chevrolet, Cottage Grove, Oregon, for three (3) Chevrolet Caprice police cars for the bid amount of \$57,046.14.

<u>Section 2</u>. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon, to complete this project as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
