

ORDINANCE NO. 967

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH PARKER NORTHWEST PAVING COMPANY FOR THE 13TH AVENUE AND S. IVY STREET SIGNALIZATION AND ROAD IMPROVEMENTS; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, Clackamas County and the City of Canby entered into a Local Agency Agreement by adopting City of Canby Resolution No. 620, to complete signalization at the intersection and road improvements of 13th Avenue and S. Ivy Street in Canby; and

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County has heretofore advertised and received bids for the 13th and S. Ivy Street Signalization and Road Improvement Project; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call for bids was duly and regularly published in the Daily Journal of Commerce on February 3, 1997;

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on February 28, 1997, 10:00 a.m. at the Clackamas County Shops on Abernethy Road, Oregon City, and the following responses were read aloud:

WHEREAS, the Clackamas County Department of Transportation Traffic Engineer, Chris Christofferson, and the City of Canby Public Works Supervisor, Roy Hester, met on March 3, 1997, 2:00 p.m., and considered the bids and reports, and recommended that the low responsive bid be selected; and

WHEREAS, the determination that the low responsive bid was that of Parker Northwest Paving Company in the amount of \$310,997.04; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Parker Northwest Paving Company for the contract price of \$310,997.05.

Section 2. The project will be funded from the Street Department Traffic Signal Line Item for \$150,000; and the remaining sum of \$160,997.05 to be funded from the Transportation SDC Fund.

Section 3. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of Canby to immediately provide the proposed traffic signal and road improvements; an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read for the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, March 19, 1997, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, April 2, 1997, commencing after the hour of 7:30 p.m., in the Council Chambers at Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
