

ORDINANCE NO. 968

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH MOORE EXCAVATION, INC. FOR CONSTRUCTION OF SE 4TH AVENUE INTO THE LOGGING ROAD INDUSTRIAL PARK, PHASE II; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received bids for the extension of SE 4th Avenue into the Logging Road Industrial Park, Phase II; and

WHEREAS, the notice of call of bids was duly and regularly published in the Oregon Daily Journal of Commerce on February 19, 1997 and February 20, 1997; and

WHEREAS, bids were received and opened on March 7, 1997 at 2:00 pm by the City Recorder, Marilyn K. Perkett, in the Canby City Hall and the following responses were read aloud:

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council, acting as the City's Contract Review Board, met on March 19, 1997, and considered the bids and reports and recommendations of the City staff, including the staff recommendation that the low responsive bid be selected; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council determined that the low responsive bid was that of Moore Excavation, Incorporated; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute, and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Moore Excavation, Inc. For extension of SE 4th Avenue for the bid amount of \$837,906.00. A copy of a contract with Moore Excavation, Inc. Is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.


Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon, to complete this project as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting therefore on Wednesday, March 19, 1997; ordered posted as required by the Canby City Charter and scheduled for second reading on Wednesday, April 2, 1997, after the hour of 7:30 pm at the Council Chambers at the Canby City Hall, 182 N. Holly, Canby, Oregon.
