

ORDINANCE NO. 971

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING PAYMENT OF ELECTRICAL WORK TO THE CANBY UTILITY BOARD PURSUANT TO AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH CLACKAMAS COUNTY FOR THE INSTALLATION OF A TRAFFIC SIGNAL AT THE INTERSECTION OF SOUTH IVY STREET/CANBY-MARQUAM HIGHWAY #170 AND SOUTH 13TH AVENUE, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Resolution No. 620, dated July 3, 1996, the City of Canby entered into an intergovernmental agreement with Clackamas County for the installation of a traffic signal at the intersection of South Ivy Street/Canby-Marquam Highway #170 and South 13th Avenue, and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the Agreement, the City of Canby agreed to pay for the electrical work needed for the project, and

WHEREAS, the Canby Utility Board will perform the electrical work for the sum of \$30,963.37, and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Charter requires an Ordinance be approved when contracts require payment of greater than \$15,000.00, now therefore,

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The City Treasurer is hereby authorized to pay the Canby Utility Board the total amount of \$ 30,963.67 for electrical work on the traffic signal located at the intersection of South Ivy/Canby-Marquam Highway #170 and South 13th Avenue.


Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby to immediately provide for the improvement at S. Ivy and 13th Ave., an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, April 16, 1997, and ordered posted in three(3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof

on Wednesday, May 7, 1997, commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Canby, Oregon.
