

ORDINANCE NO. 984

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE 982 REGARDING PROCEDURES FOR THE CREATION OF AN ECONOMIC IMPROVEMENT DISTRICT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:


Section 1. In section 1, B, 6, b, Definitions, of Ordinance No. 982, the following definition is amended to read:

b.) If mandatory, that the assessment **may** be considered a tax under the Oregon Constitution, Article XI Section 11 (b) and may be reduced to fit within the property tax limitation thereby affecting the level and scope of services described.

Section 2. Emergency Declared.

It being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Canby, that procedures regarding the formation of economic development improvement districts be implemented, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.




