AN ORDINANCE FIXING COMPENSATION FOR THE SERVICES OF CITY COUNCILPERSONS AND REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 831.

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1</u>. The duly elected and qualified Mayor for the City of Canby shall be paid from funds of the City budgeted for such purposes the sum of Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) per month, and each duly elected and qualified Councilperson shall also be paid from said funds the sum of One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per month.

<u>Section 2</u>. The payments to be made to the Mayor and Councilperson as authorized by Section 1 of this Ordinance shall commence May 1, 1998, and continue thereafter until changed by ordinance. Such payments shall be made monthly in the regular course of business and no further order, authorization, or approval for such payments shall be required.

Section 3. Neither the Mayor nor any Councilperson shall be paid for attendance at any committee meeting or other meeting of the City's officials except as noted in Section 1 of this Ordinance.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 831 enacted May 17, 1989 is hereby repealed.
