ORDINANCE NO. 1099

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH OREGON HOUSING AND ASSOCIATED SERVICES, INC., dba WHEELS COMMUNITY TRANSPORTATION OF SALEM, OREGON FOR PROVIDING BUS DRIVERS FOR THE CANBY TRANSIT SYSTEM; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby Transit Director heretofore requested proposals from service providers for operation of the bus system for the newly established Canby Transit System; and

WHEREAS, the Canby Transit Director received proposals from five (5) potential providers listed below:

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council, acting as the City's Contract Review Board, met on June 5, 2002, and considered the quotations and the reports and recommendations of the City Transit Director; and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council determined that the proposal for the bus driving services that best meet the needs of the Canby Transit System was that of Oregon Housing and Associated Services, Inc., dba as Wheels Community Transportation of Salem, Oregon; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized and directed to make,

execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Oregon Housing and Associated Services, Inc., dba Wheels Community Transportation of Salem, Oregon to provide bus driving services for the City's transit system. A copy of said contract is attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and by this reference incorporated herein.

Section 2. In as much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby to implement this ordinance in order to be able to provide its transit service to local citizens as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
