

**ORDINANCE NO. 1028**

**AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO FORMALLY ACCEPT THE WRITTEN QUOTE FROM ERNST HARDWARE CO. FOR A JOHN DEERE 5510 TRACTOR WITH A 541SL LOADER FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Canby has heretofore solicited written quotes for replacing the stolen City of Canby Wastewater Treatment Plant tractor; and

**WHEREAS**, three written quotes were received for the City specified John Deere 5510 Tractor with a 541SL Loader; and

**WHEREAS**, the written quotes received were as follows:

1. Ernst Hardware Co. Saint Paul, OR	John Deere 5510 Tractor John Deere 541SL Loader	\$25,880 <u>4,212</u> \$30,092
2. Fisher Implement Co. Gresham, OR	John Deere 5510 Tractor John Deere 541SL Loader	\$26,282 <u>4,030</u> \$30,312
3. Lenon Implement Co. Woodburn, OR	John Deere 5510 Tractor John Deere 541SL Loader	\$26,150 <u>4,475</u> \$30,625

**WHEREAS**, the Canby City Council, acting as the City Contract Review Board, met on Wednesday, July 7, 1999, and considered the written quotes and recommendations of city staff, including the staff recommendation that the low responsive quote be selected; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council determined that the low responsive written responsive was that of Ernst Hardware Co. in the amount of \$30,092.

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Administrator is hereby authorized to formally accept the written quote received from Ernst Hardware Co. of St. Paul, Oregon for the John Deere 5510 Tractor and 541SL Loader for the sum of \$30,092, fob Canby, Oregon.

Section 2. In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon to replace the stolen wastewater treatment plant tractor necessary to spread the treatment plant output product upon approved farm locations without further delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this

ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
