ORDINANCE NO. 1030

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AMENDING THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF CANBY AND KEN ROBINSON, D.B.A. K&R MAINTENANCE, FOR THE OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF THE ZION MEMORIAL CEMETERY; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, a contract was entered into on or about February 19, 1996, effective March 1, 1996, with Ken Robinson, d.b.a. K&R Maintenance ; and

WHEREAS, the City developed an additional 1.03 acre cemetery parcel and required K&R Maintenance to operate and maintain the parcel at a cost of \$8,040 per year; and

WHEREAS, K&R has requested an 8% increase to cover inflation increases for labor and materials; and

WHEREAS, the City has budgeted \$86,040 for fiscal year 2000 for the agreement.

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council, acting as the City Contract Review Board, met on Wednesday, July 7, 1999, and considered the amendment to Paragraph 4. A. of the said agreement increasing the annual compensation from \$72,000 to \$86,040; and

WHEREAS, the City Council determined that the increase fair and reasonable and in the best interests of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The City Administrator is hereby authorized to execute an amendment to Paragraph 4. A. to read as follows:

The City agrees to pay Contractor \$7,170 per month for the services provided, not to exceed a total of \$86,040 per year.

Section 2. All other terms and conditions of the original contract shall remain in full force and effect..

<u>Section 3.</u> In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon to have continuous excellent services for the operation and maintenance of the Zion Memorial Cemetery without further delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting therefore on Wednesday, August 18, 1999, after the hour of 7:30 PM at the Council Chambers located at 155 SW 2nd Avenue, Canby, Oregon.
