## ORDINANCE NO. 1038

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH WALKER-MACY FOR PROFESSIONAL SERVICES FOR THE DESIGN OF PROPOSED PUBLIC IMPROVEMENTS TO THE THIRTEENTH AVENUE PARK/ACKERMAN SCHOOL COMPLEX; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to develop a design for a recreation complex utilizing the City-owned property on Thirteenth Avenue together with adjoining School District owned property (the Ackerman Middle School grounds), including Canby Adult Center and Canby Swim Center; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to employ Walker-Macy, landscape design architects, as an independent contractor under a personal services contract for the purpose of carrying out the public input process and producing the resultant design; and

WHEREAS, Walker-Macy has proposed a personal services contract for preparing the recreation complex design as requested which is acceptable to the City, now therefore

## THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Walker-Macy for preparation of a recreation complex design for the Thirteenth Avenue/Ackerman complex. The copy of said contract is attached hereto and marked as Exhibit "A" and by this reference fully incorporated herein.

Section 2. Emergency Declared.

It being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Canby, that these public improvements be completed as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 3, 1999, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday. November 17, 1999, commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
