## ORDINANCE NO. 1044

## AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH GRESHAM FORD OF GRESHAM, OREGON, FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2000 FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE INTERCEPTOR AUTOMOBILE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to purchase a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor automobile to be used by the Traffic Safety Officer of the Canby Police Department; and

**WHEREAS**, the purchase will be made in compliance with ORS 279.015 (1)(g)(A) utilizing an existing solicitation for the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, Gresham Ford of Gresham, Oregon submitted the low bid for the police interceptor automobiles according to the required specifications of the State of Oregon Motor Pool purchasing department under Contract No. PA-7501; now therefore

## THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Gresham Ford of Gresham, Oregon to purchase a 2000 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor automobile for the bid amount of \$27,480.00.

Section 2. Emergency Declared.

It being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Canby, that this Police vehicle be put into use as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
