AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE PURCHASE OF A GMC 4X4 PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$24,498.00 FROM DIESEL SERVICE UNIT OF PORTLAND, OREGON; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, it is determined that City staff has valid needs, requirements and expectations for a new 4x4 pickup truck, and that City staff analyzed their job requirements and needs and properly concluded that the procurement of a 4x4 pickup truck would increase work efficiency and effectiveness, provide substantial cost savings and directly benefit the citizens of Canby; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS Chapter 279 and OAR Chapter 137 of the Public Contracting Law, six sealed bids were obtained on a 4x4 pickup truck; and

WHEREAS, Diesel Service Unit of Portland, Oregon submitted the low bid in the amount of \$24,498.00 for a GMC 4X4 pickup truck meeting the City bid specifications; and

WHEREAS, the City staff has budgeted for the GMC Pickup in the Motor Pool Reserve Equipment-Sewer for the fiscal year 2000 budget (214-214-425-7413); and

WHEREAS, the Canby City Council, acting as the City Contract Review Board, met on March 15, 2000 and considered the purchase of the GMC 4x4 Pickup Truck from Diesel Service Unit of Portland, Oregon in the amount of \$24, 498.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

The City Administrator is hereby authorized to purchase the GMC 4x4 Pickup Section 1. Truck from Diesel Service Unit of Portland, Oregon for the bid price of \$24,498.00.

In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon to have Section 2. continuous excellent services for the operation and maintenance of the Wastewater Treatment Facility and to avoid unnecessary added cost to the taxpayers without further delay, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
