

ORDINANCE NO. 1077

AN ORDINANCE CONSENTING TO CLACKAMAS COUNTY ADMINISTERING IT'S DOG CONTROL AND LICENSING ORDINANCE WITHIN THE CITY, REPEALING CHAPTER 6.12 OF THE CANBY MUNICIPAL CODE; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to have Clackamas County Dog Control administer it's dog control and licensing ordinance, Title 5, Chapter 5.01 within the City; and

WHEREAS, ORS 203.040 requires formal consent be given by the City of Canby for a county ordinance to apply within the City; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. Consent Granted.

The City hereby grants consent to Clackamas County to administer the county's dog control and licensing ordinance, Clackamas County Code Chapter 5.01, within the City.

Section 2. Repeal.

Chapter 6.12 of the Canby Municipal Code is hereby repealed..

Section 3. Emergency Declared.

It being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Canby, that Clackamas County be authorized to administer it's dog control and licensing ordinance within the City as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, August 15, 2001, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, September 5, 2001, commencing at the hour of 7:30

P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Canby, Oregon.
