

ORDINANCE NO. 1084

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY RECORDER TO EXECUTE AMENDMENT NUMBER 3 TO THE AGREEMENT FOR ENGINEERING SERVICES DATED FEBRUARY 3, 1998 WITH CURRAN-McLEOD, INC. TO PROVIDE ENGINEERING SERVICES FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT FACILITY PHASE II EFFLUENT FILTRATION PROJECT, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$74,600; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has heretofore advertised and received proposals for engineering services, completed oral interviews and selected CURRAN-McLEOD, INC. to complete needed engineering services for the Wastewater Treatment Facility, Phase II improvements including effluent filtration; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has an existing Agreement for Engineering Services dated February 3, 1998 with CURRAN-McLEOD, INC. for these services on the Wastewater Treatment Facility, Phase II improvements; and

WHEREAS, CURRAN-McLEOD, INC. has provided facility planning, predesign report and engineering and construction cost estimates for the Effluent Filtration improvements to the Wastewater Treatment Facility; and

WHEREAS, the City of Canby has budgeted expenditures for this work in FY 2001-2002; and

WHEREAS, proceeding with the Effluent Filtration improvements jointly with the current Solids Dewatering project underway at the Treatment Facility will permit efficiencies and reduction of engineering fees and construction cost; Now, therefore,


THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Recorder are hereby authorized on behalf of the City of Canby, to execute Amendment Number 3 to the February 3, 1998 Agreement for Engineering Services with CURRAN-McLEOD, INC. in an amount not to exceed \$74,600.

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby, Oregon, to complete this project as soon as possible, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.


