

ORDINANCE NO. 1104

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINSTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH STERNBERG VINTAGE LIGHTING OF NILES, ILLINOIS TO PURCHASE 30 STREET LIGHTS, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, The City of Canby requires thirty street lights to complete the N. Ivy Street and NW Second Avenue street projects; and

WHEREAS, The City solicited requests for written quotes from four providers and received two bids for lights of the appropriate make and size;

WHEREAS, The Canby City Council, acting as the City's Contract Review Board, met on August 21, 2002, and considered the price quotes and the staff recommendation; and

WHEREAS, The Council determined that the lowest quote meeting all requirements was that of Sternberg;

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute, and declare in the name of the City of Canby on its behalf, an appropriate contract to purchase from Sternberg Vintage Lighting of Niles, IL, thirty street lights for the quoted price of \$36,480.
- (2) Since it is in the best interest of the citizens of Canby to implement this ordinance as soon as possible in order to provide lighting on N. Ivy Street and NW Second Avenue, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on August 21, 2002, ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City for a period of five (5) days, as authorized by the Canby City Charter; and to come up for final reading and action by the Canby City Council at a regular meeting thereof on September 4, 2002, commencing after the hour of 7:30 p.m., at the Council's regular meeting chambers at the Canby City Hall in Canby, Oregon.
