

ORDINANCE NO. 1156

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH BRUCE CHEVROLET OF HILLSBORO, OREGON FOR THE PURCHASE OF ONE 2005 CHEVROLET SILVERADO $\frac{3}{4}$ TON TRUCK FOR THE CANBY PARKS DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to purchase a new Chevrolet Silverado $\frac{3}{4}$ ton truck for the City's Parks Department; and

WHEREAS, the purchase will be made from Oregon Department of Administrative Services (DAS) in compliance with ORS 279.820 - 279.855 utilizing an existing solicitation for the State of Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) under State of Oregon Bid No. 10200041 01; and

WHEREAS, DAS concurs with the City of Canby utilizing the existing solicitation and this purchase is in cooperation with the ORCPP; and

WHEREAS, Bruce Chevrolet of Hillsboro, Oregon submitted the low bid of Sixteen Thousand, Eight Hundred & Fifty-One dollars and Fifty cents (\$16,851.50) for one Chevrolet Silverado $\frac{3}{4}$ Ton Truck according to the required specifications of the State of Oregon; and

WHEREAS, the City Council meeting and acting as the Contract Review Board for the City of Canby has reviewed this bid and believes it to be in the best interest of the City to accept such bid; now therefore


THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Bruce Chevrolet of Hillsboro, Oregon for one Chevrolet Silverado $\frac{3}{4}$ Ton Truck for the bid amount of Sixteen Thousand, Eight Hundred & Fifty-One dollars and Fifty cents (\$16,851.50)

Section 2. Inasmuch as it is in the best interests of the City of Canby Parks Department to put this vehicle into service as quickly as possible, an emergency is

hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, October 20, 2004 and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 3, 2004 commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Canby, Oregon.


