ORDINANCE NO. 1162

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH LANDMARK FORD OF TIGARD, OREGON FOR THE LEASE/PURCHASE OF TWO (2) 2005 FORD CROWN VICTORIA POLICE INTERCEPTORS WITH POLICE EQUIPMENT PACKAGES FOR THE CANBY POLICE DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to lease/purchase two (2) 2005 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors with full police equipment packages for the Canby Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the vehicles and equipment will be paid by the Canby Police Department which has budgeted said purchase for the fiscal year 2004-2005 budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS Chapter 279 and OAR Chapter 137 of the Public Contracting Law, three written bids were obtained for the purchase of the two police interceptor vehicles as follows:

1. Family Ford:

\$ 45,374.00.

2. Gresham Ford:

\$ 44,288.00.

3. Landmark Ford:

\$ 44,062.00.

WHEREAS, Landmark Ford of Tigard, Oregon submitted the lowest quote of \$44,062.00 for two (2) vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the City Council meeting and acting as the Contract Review Board for the City of Canby has reviewed this quote, reviewed the staff report and believes it to be in the best interest of the City to purchase these vehicles from Landmark Ford; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate lease/purchase contract with Landmark Ford of Tigard, Oregon for the lease/purchase of two (2) 2005 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptors, together with police equipment packages for the quoted amount of \$ 52,713.74.

Section 2. In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Canby, Oregon to provide the Police Department with these vehicles without further delay, and to better serve the citizens of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, December 1, 2004, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, December 15, 2004, commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Capby, Oregon.
