

ORDINANCE NO. 1163

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH GRESHAM FORD OF GRESHAM, OREGON FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2005 FORD EXTENDED CAB ½ TON PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE CANBY FLEET SERVICES DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to purchase a new extended cab, two wheel drive ½ ton Ford pickup truck for the Fleet Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the equipment will be paid by the Fleet Services Department which has budgeted said purchase for the fiscal year 2004-2005 budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS Chapter 279 and OAR Chapter 137 of the Public Contracting Law, four written bids were obtained for the purchase of the mobile data computers and modems as follows:

WHEREAS, Gresham Ford of Gresham, Oregon submitted the lowest quote of \$ 16,612.94; and

WHEREAS, the City Council meeting and acting as the Contract Review Board for the City of Canby has reviewed this quote, reviewed the staff report and believes it to be in the best interest of the City to purchase this vehicle from Gresham Ford ; now therefore


THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Gresham Ford or Gresham, Oregon for the purchase of a 2005 Ford pickup for the quoted amount of \$ 16,612.94.

Section 2. In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of

Canby, Oregon to provide the Fleet Services Department with this truck without further delay, and to better serve the citizens of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, October 20, 2004, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on Wednesday, November 3, 2004, commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Canby, Oregon.


