ORDINANCE NO. 1171

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH SIGNATURE PAVING SERVICES, INC., OF NEWBERG, OREGON FOR THE INSTALLATION OF NEW PATHWAYS AND RESURFACING OF EXISTING PATHWAYS FOR THE MAPLE STREET PARK RENOVATION PROJECT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to install new pathways and resurface existing pathways in Maple Street Park to complete the terms of the grant received from the Oregon State Parks Department for the renovation of the Park; and

WHEREAS, the City has prepared a solicitation including BOLI wage rate provisions and a timeline that is required for the successful installation of the paving project in order to accomplish the work in as timely a manner as possible for the next sports season; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS Chapter 279 and OAR Chapter 137 of the Public Contracting Law, at least three written bids were solicited for this paving project with the following results:

1.	Coast Pavement Services of Tigard, OR	\$48,685.00
2.	Hal's Construction, Inc., of Oregon City, OR	\$44,291.00
3.	Signature Paving Services, Inc., of Newberg, OR	\$40,400.00

WHEREAS, the City of Canby Parks Department has reviewed the quotes and recommends the City accept the low bid from Signature Paving Services, Inc., and

WHEREAS, the City Council meeting and acting as the Contract Review Board for the City of Canby has reviewed the quotes and believes it to in the best interest of the City to accept the low bid from Signature Paving Services, Inc., now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

<u>Section 1.</u> The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and

directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate contract with Signature Paving Services, Inc., of Newberg, Oregon for installation of new pathways and the resurfacing of existing pathways for Maple Street Park for the quoted amount of \$40,400.00.

Section 2. Emergency Declared.

It being necessary for the health, safety and general welfare of the citizens of Canby, that these public improvements be completed as soon as possible to allow use of the Park, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.
