

ORDINANCE NO. 1187

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY ADMINISTRATOR TO EXECUTE A CONTRACT WITH CANBY FORD OF CANBY, OREGON FOR THE PURCHASE OF A 2006 FORD EXTENDED CAB 1/2 TON PICKUP TRUCK FOR THE CANBY WASTE WATER TREATMENT DEPARTMENT; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the City of Canby wishes to purchase a new extended cab, two wheel drive, ½ ton Ford F150 Pickup Truck for the Waste Water Treatment Department; and

WHEREAS, the cost of the vehicle will be paid by the Waste Water Treatment Department which has budgeted said purchase for the fiscal year 2005-2006 budget; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with ORS Chapter 279 and Canby Public Purchasing Rules as set forth in Ordinance No. 1170 and Resolution No. 897, four written bids were obtained for the purchase of the 2006 Ford F150 Pickup Truck as follows:

WHEREAS, Canby Ford of Canby, Oregon submitted the lowest quote of \$ 17,781.00; and


WHEREAS, the City Council meeting and acting as the Contract Review Board for the City of Canby has reviewed this quote, reviewed the staff report and believes it to be in the best interest of the City to purchase this vehicle from Canby Ford; now therefore

THE CITY OF CANBY ORDAINS AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. The Mayor and City Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to make, execute and declare in the name of the City of Canby and on its behalf, an appropriate purchase contract with Canby Ford of Canby, Oregon for the purchase of 2006 Ford F150 ½ ton, extended cab, 2 wheel drive Pickup Truck in the amount of \$17,781.00.

Section 2. In so much as it is in the best interest of the citizens of the City of Canby, Oregon to provide the Sewer Department with this vehicle without further delay, and to better serve the citizens of Canby, an emergency is hereby declared to exist and this ordinance shall therefore take effect immediately upon its enactment after final reading.

SUBMITTED to the Canby City Council and read the first time at a regular meeting thereof on September 7th, 2005, and ordered posted in three (3) public and conspicuous places in the City of Canby as specified in the Canby City Charter and to come before the City Council for final reading and action at a regular meeting thereof on September 21st, 2005, commencing at the hour of 7:30 P.M. in the Council Meeting Chambers at Canby City hall in Canby, Oregon.


