Liquor License Application / Born & Raised

I have reviewed the attached liquor license application completed by the applicant, Rachelle Davis, for the business, "Born & Raised", located at 486 NW 3rd Ave, Canby, Oregon.

On January 13, 2016, I spoke with applicant Ms. Davis and we discussed the laws involving the sale of alcoholic beverages. She told me she is familiar with the Oregon liquor laws, stating she has prior experience in the liquor industry. Ms. Davis said she was well as the other business partners (Ben McKay, Martin Nash and Marilyn Nash) have recently received training on the liquor laws from OLCC.

Ms. Davis said at this time, the business is only open on Fridays and Saturdays, and in addition to the listed business partners, there are only two part-time employees. She said she will ensure the employees are trained on the liquor laws as well. Additionally, she said she understands the consequences for failure to comply with the rules as set forth by Oregon State law.

It is my recommendation that the Canby City Council approve this application to the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC).
