I have reviewed the attached OLCC liquor license application for Off Premises Sales for the business Ebner Custom Meats, located at 272 N Grant Street, Canby, Oregon.

On April 6, 2011, I spoke with Michael Ebner, who owns 75% of the business and I was told he will be working closely with OLCC as it relates to the necessary training for his employees on pertinent laws involving alcohol sales and related violations and crimes related to employee's failure to comply with the law. Additionally, on October 18, 2011, I spoke with James Page, who owns 25% of the business and I was told he will also be working closely with OLCC as it relates to the necessary training for his employees. Mr. Ebner and Mr. Page said it is their intention to serve beer and wine with custom meat products from their market on-site. On October 18, 2011, I recommended the Canby City Council approve the request as it was written on the application.

The business, Ebner Custom Meats, has been compliant with OLCC and no issues of concern have been reported.


I recommend the Canby City Council approve the request as it is written in the application and received by the City of Canby on August 10, 2012.
