Canby City Council Regular Meeting March 21, 1977

The meeting was reconvened at 7:00 P.M. by the Mayor, followed by the traditional flag salute.

Ordinance No. 617; AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 416 TO PROVIDE FOR INCREASED DEPOSITS TO THE CEMETERY SINKING FUND; was then read on final reading, title only, by the City Attorney. Councilman Giger moved to pass Ordinance No. 617 on final reading, seconded by Councilman Knight and passed by roll call vote with 5 ayes and 0 nays.

Ordinance No. 618; AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CITY'S SANITATION ORDINANCE NO. 566 TO INCREASE SEWER CONNECTION CHARGES AND RATES FOR SEWER SERVICE; AND PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; was then read on final reading, title only, by the City Attorney. Councilman Swayze moved to pass Ordinance No. 618 on final reading, seconded by Councilman Giger and passed by roll call vote with 5 ayes and 0 nays.

Resolution No. 222; A RESOLUTION OF SUPPORT FOR THE OREGON LIBRARY ASSOCIATION'S REQUEST FOR STATE AID FOR PUBLIC LIBRARIES; was read in its entirety by the City Attorney. Councilman Westcott moved to pass Resolution No. 222 as read by the City Attorney, seconded by Councilman Giger and passed unanimously.

The Accounts Payable was the next item of business, at which time Councilman Giger moved to pass the Accounts Payable in the amount of \$36,385.82, seconded by Councilman Knight and passed by roll call vote with 5 ayes and 0 nays.

Mayor Rapp then set the date of Wednesday, March 30, 1977, 7:30 P.M. for a Council Workshop.

After a lengthy discussion a date of Wednesday, March 23, 1977, 7:30 P.M. was set for an Executive Session to discuss personnel matters.

The meeting was then adjourned.
