

REGULAR MEETING OF
Canby City Council - March 20, 1972

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Braman at 8:18 p.m. in the Council Chambers. Due to an overflow number of persons present, the Mayor announced that the meeting would be recessed and reconvened at the auditorium of the Canby Middle School.

The meeting was then called to order at the Middle School at 8:45 p.m. followed by the flag salute.

Roll Call: Present - Mayor Braman and Councilmen Giger, Keil, Lindsay, Raines, Tate and Wagner. Absent - None.

Others Present - ~~acting attorney~~ Wade Bettis Jr., Supt. Herbison, Asst. Whiteside, Utility Manager Rundle, Secretaries Lewelling and Hieb and Public Works Foreman Atwood.

Mayor Braman declared the time had come to open bids for Radio Equipment as published by notice in the Canby Herald. The following bids were opened and read by Supt. Herbison: General Electric, total bid - \$11,467.00, Alternate - \$9,541.00; and Motorola, total bid - \$14,181.00 and alternate - \$6,562.00. The Mayor referred the bids to a committee consisting of Councilmen Tate & Keil and department heads Herbison, Rundle and Rodewald for evaluation and recommendations to the Council.

Then Mayor Braman reiterated what he said he had recommended to a recent Personnel Committee meeting that the Council request the resignation of Chief of Police Walter. Thereupon, Councilman Giger made a motion that Walter be relieved of his duties immediately. The motion was seconded by Councilman Lindsay. The preamble to a petition signed by 234 persons and presented to the City before the meeting, was read by the Recorder prior to discussion by the Council and persons in the audience. Said petition is attached to and becomes a part of the copy of these minutes. Principals who spoke in favor of the motion were Officer Andrew Stellato (who turned in his badge until the matter be resolved) Warren Cox, Karen Wallace, Larry Whitman, Helen Richmond, Lois Larson, Virginia Doney and Councilman Giger. Those who spoke in defense of Chief Walter included Loyd Younce, Gary Day, Roy Pottratz, Barry Rudd and Councilman Tate. After approximately one hour of discussion, Councilman Giger called for the question. The Mayor's request for a roll call vote resulted in defeat of the motion by a vote of 4 to 2. Councilman Tate had said that this was a personnel problem and asked to delay the vote on the motion, but the demand from the floor was that the Council act before the audience. Both Councilmen Lindsay and Raines strongly expressed their respective feelings regarding the outcome of the vote. Lindsay commended Mayor Braman and stated that "we should stand behind him."

Ordinance No. 549, AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN ENGINEERING STUDY OF THE CITY'S STORM WATER DRAIN SYSTEM, SANITARY SEWER COLLECTION SYSTEM AND SERVICE AREAS; APPROVING A CONTRACT WITH ZAROSINSKI-TATONE ENGINEERS, INC. TO MAKE THE STUDY AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was read on final reading by title only by the Recorder. A motion was made by Councilman Giger, seconded by Tate and carried unanimously by roll call vote that Ordinance No. 549 be adopted and become a part of the laws of Canby.

Sue Cox approached the Council requesting that the City grade the parking lot at the Community Swimming Pool and provide enough asphalt to connect the existing sidewalks. The Council discussed the matter and referred it to Supt. Herbison for investigation and recommendations.

Lawrence Housen approached the Council with written requests from Canby Civic Improvement, Inc. and from both the Canby Grade and High Schools and a petition containing 46 signatures requesting the re-paving of South Elm Street. The documents are attached to and become a part of the file copy of these minutes.


The personnel committee reported a recommendation that Louie Cole be paid for one more month's salary, upon receipt of a letter from Cole that he present no more claims. A motion was made by Councilman Giger, seconded by Lindsay and carried unanimously adopting the committee's recommendation.


Upon the Mayor's recommendation, a motion was made by Councilman Tate, seconded by Wagner and carried unanimously granting Police Officer Charles Nastasia a 90 day leave of absence.

It was announced that the personnel committee would meet with a representative from PER at 7 p.m. on Tuesday, March 21st.

Mayor Braman then declared the meeting recessed to be reconvened for further business at 8 p.m. on Tuesday March 21st.

The meeting was recessed at 10:05 p.m.


Gentlemen:

At recent meetings of the Board of Directors of Canby Civic Improvement, Inc., the almost impassable condition of South Elm Street, from 4th street past the Community Clinic, has been under discussion. After two known accidents have occurred and the Clinic Doctors as well as the Grade School and High School administrators expressed concern, it was felt by the directors of this community organization that a request for help should be directed to the City of Canby.

I was appointed to visit with the city officials, make the conditions of the street known and request the city's help in repairing this section of street which is used extensively by the school busses, as well as Clinic patients. The citizens concerned recognize well the financial situation of the street department and under a less drastic situation, would not make this request for immediate attention.

WHEREAS, Canby's police chief has over-expanded his department's budgets by \$22,332.00, WITHOUT AUTHORITY in most cases, in the past two fiscal years and indications are that he is exceeding his budget for the third time, and

WHEREAS, other City departments must carry the burden of sacrificing to make up for the deficit created by his inefficiency and ineptness, and

WHEREAS, he consistently exceeds his normally budgeted salary of \$895 per month by billing the City for "extras, " ignoring rules of the Council, and

WHEREAS, his harassment and pressure on those in his department have forced one officer into serious illness and the need for open heart surgery before he can return to work and have provided him no State Accident Insurance Fund benefits to date, and have caused four others (trained in police work at City expense) to resign since January 1970, and

WHEREAS, his arbitrary and dictatorial actions are detrimental to the performance of those in his department, and

WHEREAS, his hiring of personnel and making of major purchases without advance Council sanction are in open disregard of the City Charter and are evidence of insubordination,

THEREFORE, we, the undersigned citizens of Canby and vicinity interested in fair and just law enforcement, earnestly implore you and the Council to remove without delay Ronal Von Walter from the position of Chief of Police and from the City of Canby payroll, and

THEREFORE, we request that law enforcement again can be put on the proper basis in Canby and a qualified, conscientious and able administrator with public confidence be placed in charge.

WE BELIEVE there is urgent need for this action.

NOTE: We earnestly request that the police department not have any access to this petition in order to protect the signers from any possible recrimination.
