

SPECIAL COUNCIL MEETING  
Canby City Council, April 30, 1963.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor at 8 p.m.

Roll Call: Present - Mayor Stefani and Councilmen Giger, Graham, Harper, Housen, Read and Stevens. Absent - None.  
Others Present - Sup't Cox, Assist. Bentz and Officer Lindsay.

Mayor Stefani announced the principal purpose of the meeting was to interview four police applicants that had been selected by the Police Committee, and turned the interview over to Police Commissioner Housen.

Commissioner Housen read each application and reference information before calling the applicant in before the Council. The applicants in turn were Arnold Irwin Goldberg, Dalmer Hobbs Bates, Floyd Arthur Connon and Clayton Frederick Metzger.


After due consideration was given to each application, a tie vote resulted for two applicants and Mayor Stefani cast the deciding vote in favor of Dalmer Bates. Councilman Housen advised the applicants of the Council's decision and brought Bates before the Council as the new police officer.

Bates was advised of some of the requirements of the department and that the beginning wage had been set at \$350.00 to be reconsidered after six months probationary period. Bates said he would be available after May 2 and the date of May 8 was tentitively set for him to begin work.

Chairman Giger of the Wage and Hour Committee read the recommendation of the Committee for wage rates for the 1963-64 fiscal year. Discussion followed regarding the rate for extra help at the cemetery. The Council agreed to pay \$2.00 per hour plus rental for machinery used. The Recorder questioned the rate of \$350 per month for clerk-bookkeeper Ardelle Eppers and assured the Council that she would not be satisfied with that wage. Mayor Stefani advised the Recorder to discuss the matter with Mrs. Eppers and report to the Council at the next meeting.

A motion was made by Councilman Read, seconded by Graham and carried unanimously to adopt the recommendations of the Wage and Hour Committee, a copy of which is recorded in the minute file.

The meeting was adjourned at 10:55 p.m.
