

SPECIAL MEETING OF  
Canby City Council, May 22, 1961.

The meeting was called to order by the Mayor at 9 p.m.

Roll Call: Present - Mayor Oliver, Councilmen Giger, Graham, Housen,  
Markee and Stefani. Absent Councilman Anderson.  
Others Present - Supt Cox and Recorder Richardson acting in Capacity  
of Budget Clerk.

Reading of the minutes of the proceeding meeting was postponed until the next regular meeting.

Mayor Oliver announced the death of Councilman Anderson, Monday morning and called for a moments reverence in honor of the deceased Councilman. The Mayor requested that the Canby business establishments close from 1:30 to 3 p.m. on Thursday, May 25 during the funeral. The Council instructed the Recorder to order a floral piece for the occasion.

The Council reviewed a contract from Southern Pacific Co. for sidewalk right-of-way across the railroad property in Canby, and referred the contract to the Supt. and City Attorney for study and presentation at the next regular meeting.

The Mayor announced that this was the time and place for the preliminary review of the 1961-62 budget. The Budget Clerk announced a similiar meeting with the appointed budget board as called for Monday, May 29 at 8 p.m. Don Evans, having indicated that he would not be available for the coming budget sessions, the Mayor stated that he would appoint an alternate.

The entire compliment of the estimated receipts and budget proposals were read by the clerk with opportunity for intervening discussion and suggested revisions by members of the Council. The Mayor advised that the revisions be made before the proposals were read to the appointed budget board.

The meeting was adjourned at 11:30 p.m.
