

Regular Meeting City Council June 6th, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8:10 PM

Roll call: Present, Mayor Irwin; Councilmen, Anderson, H. Giger, V. Giger
Oliver, Kermit Osness and F. Stefani.

Sup't Lee Cox and Attorney Wade Bettis.

Minutes of the previous meetings of May 16th, 23rd and 31st read and approved.

Sam Amundson again appeared before the Council discussing for about 45 minutes Ordinance #429 and the contract covering the Beck well. His various points of opposition were answered by the Mayor and Councilmen.

Sup't Lee Cox presented matter of various stock material and equipment needs of the City. V. Giger moved seconded by Anderson that the City purchase from the Light Dep't funds six 37½ KVA Moloney transformers 12470/7200, three 25 KVA ditto, Two 15 KVA ditto, six 37½ KVA ditto no taps, two 15 KVA ditto no taps, 5000 ft #2 Shark wire, 48 single phase meters dial 200-A GE 160s, 500 8010 Fargo Conn., 150-189 Watt series lamps, 100-EHI Merc. Vapor Lamps, at a total cost of \$2,295.75. And Line Poles 10 Pcs 35' Class 4, 15 Pcs 40' class 4, 10 Pcs 45' class 4 and 5 Pcs 50 ft class 4, all treated at a price of \$1,425.25. Motion carried.

V. Giger moved seconded by H. Giger that the light dep't purchase the following equipment at the price of \$3,839.00: 1 only air compressor C.P. Serial #61633 59 125 cfm Gyro-Flo (\$2,850), 1 only paving breaker Ingersall-Rand #65 (\$149), 164 ft 3/4" air hose & fittings (\$100) 6 Pcs tool steel for paving breakers (\$29.50), 1 only Jack hammer C.P. #55 1 1/8" Hex (\$349), 2 only six foot sects steel for Jack hammer (\$23.10), 1 only C.P. Air temp. #123 (\$249) and 1 only 3/4 Tom Coffin hoist (\$90). Also one only used Vibratory Compactor G.M. 15 "TERRAPAC" at \$450.00. Motion carried. Motion further to read that an emergency be declared to exist and that the purchase be made without advertising for bids (Account special half price offer for immediate sale) Carried.

Fire Chief Norman Christiansen read his monthly report for May. Recorder gave report of Police Court cases and Cemetery income for May. Sup't Cox also gave work report for May. All reports placed on file.

H. Giger moved claims against City for May be allowed and warrants drawn on Treasurer for payment of same. Seconded by Stefani. Roll call Vote Yeas 6 Nays 0.

Oliver moved Council have recorder write a letter to Mr. John Beck to withhold purchase of and installation of chlorinator until such time as water tests reveal the need for chlorination. Motion seconded by H. Giger and carried.

The Council approved installation of lighting at the City Park for horse shoe pitching if some responsible individual is named as responsible for control of the light switch and payment of the light bill.

The Mayor appointed Fred Stefani to serve on the Wage and Hour Committee to replace Mr. Eversole and named Virgil Giger as chairman of this committee. The third member is Howard Giger.

The Mayor also appointed Elmer Anderson as chairman of the Street Committee and Kermit Osness as chairman of the Police Dep't and Public Properties.
