Special meeting Canby City Council July 25th, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor George Irwin.

Present: Mayor Irwin

Councilmen, Anderson, H.Giger, Oliver, Osness & Stefani. Sup't Lee Cox.

Due to the breakdown of the City road roller Supit Cox desired the Council to consider whether to repair the old roller or consider the purchase of a new roller. After general discussion it was agreed by the Council to invite some demonstrations of new rollers and consider the purchase of new equipment.

Sup't Cox advised the Council that work should be done immediately on plans and specifications for the relocation of power lines and water mains on account of the widening of Highway 99-E. Due to a heavy working program on other City work the Council authorized Sup't Cox to engage a draftsman to take care of this work for the City.

Also Sup't Cox advised he had consulted with the Southern Pacific engineering department in regard to construction of a pedestrian walk on Elm Street between the Highway 99-E and First Avenue. He reported the S.P. was willing to co-operate but desired plans submitted to them in which they should be permitted to specify material and construction across their tracks. It was agreed to draw up plans and proceed with an agreement with the Southern Pacific and construction of the walk.

Sup't Cox suggested trimming of the shrubs on the corner of the property belonging to Mr.F.H.Stajgr on the corner of Elm Street and S.W.4th Avenue to relieve an obstructed traffic view. Also that a stop line be painted across the street at this intersection.

The Recorder was instructed to write a letter to Ancel Dunn requesting that the $\frac{1}{2}$ H.P.Jacuzzi shallow well pump and 60 gallon tank belonging to the Fire Department be returned to the City. Pump was purchased in 1957 by the Fire Dep't for the new City Park on the river.

Subject to use of City water by the Fair Grounds was again discussed. Chairman Oliver of the water committee reported he had met with the Fair Board and an agreement had been reached to work out an estimate of water used by them with the Fair Grounds Sup't, Clinton Perkett.
