

Regular Meeting Canby Council Jan 18th, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor George Irwin at 805 PM

Roll Call: Present: Mayor Irwin, Councilmen Anderson, H. Giger, Oliver & Stefani.
Sup't Ancel Dunn and Attorney Wade Bettis
Absent: Councilmen Rex Eversole and Virgil Giger.

Minutes of the previous regular meeting read and approved.

City Treasurer, Curtis E. Johnson Jr., submitted and read to the Council his quarterly Treasurer's report showing a total of all accounts at the figure of \$170,296.40. Howard Giger made motion seconded by Fred Stefani that the report be accepted and placed on file. Carried.

Statement for \$7000.00 sewer bonds and interest due Feb 1st 1960 presented. H. Giger made motion seconded by Earl Oliver for payment of these bonds and interest. Roll call vote: Yeas 4 Nays 0.

Annual report of Chief of Police, Loyd Younce, read by Elmer Anderson, Police Department Chairman and placed on file.

An application for Police work was submitted by Richard C. Anderson of 531 Willamette St., Oregon City. Letter to be answered and placed on file. No further action taken at this time.

The Mayor asked Attorney Wade Bettis to explain to the Council proper procedures and information regarding the proposed referendum movement against Ordinance No. 429, and meeting the requirements of City Ordinance No. 380 regarding referendum regulations. Mr. Bettis informed the Council that referendum rights were clearly established but that petitions must be filed not later than thirty (30) days after the date of the final passage and adoption of the ordinance.

Considerable open discussion followed expressing the Council's desire that this referendum action be completed as quickly as possible and with the hope that the voters will support Ordinance 429 as they become fully informed of the merits of the Council's action.

The Council desired the Water Committee to meet with Mr. Beck to discuss matters with him and to invite Consulting Engineer, Carl E. Green, to attend the next regular meeting of the Council.

Ordinance No. 431, AN ORDINANCE REPEALING ORDINANCE NO. 415; AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 394 TO PERMIT DETERMINATION BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF SEWER CONNECTION PERMIT CHARGES; AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY, was read by Attorney Bettis on final reading. H. Giger moved and Earl Oliver seconded that Ordinance No. 431 be adopted. Roll call vote: Yeas 4 Nays 0.

Meeting adjourned at 9:40 PM.
