

Regular meeting Canby City Council
Feb. 15th, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8 PM.

Roll call: Present, Mayor Geo. Irwin
Councilmen, Anderson, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger, Oliver & Stefani
Attorney Wade Bottis
Absent: Sup't Ancel Dunn.

Minutes of previous regular meeting read and approved.

Mr. Al Seida reported as to progress in obtaining signatures for forming a sewer district in connection with his Trailer Park development. He reported that at this time the Union Oil Company preferred not to sign an application, but that the majority of the property owners were signing and willing to enter into a sewer contract or formation of a sewer district. Such a petition was presented. V. Giger moved seconded by Stefani to accept the petition of property owners signing application for sewer connection agreement. Carried.

The Council also approved an application from Glen and Elsie Cutsforth for permit to construct and connect a building sewer to the City's sanitary sewer for the lump sum permit charge of \$65.00. The property to be connected is described as lot one (1) Block (5) North Canby.

Mr. Sam Amundson again appeared and spoke before the Council reviewing the reasons for the petitions for a referendum against Ordinance No. 429 and objections to this ordinance and proposed agreement for use and/or purchase of Mr. Beck's well.

Motion made by Howard Giger seconded by Eversole that the Recorder be authorized to attend a one day conference of Recorders at Bend Oregon April 22nd and allow expenses for same. Carried.

Some claims against the City presented. Moved by H. Giger and seconded by V. Giger that claims be allowed and warrants drawn on Treasurer in payment thereof. Roll call vote: Yeas 6 Nays 0. Carried.

The Mayor presented the resignation of Sup't of Public Works, Ancel Dunn, to become effective March 15th. Eversole moved and Oliver seconded acceptance of this resignation. Carried. The Mayor then expressed appreciation and commendation for Mr. Dunn's services to the City.

The Recorder was then instructed by the Council to publish advertisements in the Western City magazine and the Daily Journal of Commerce for written applications for the position of Sup't of Public Works.

City parking discussion followed. Rex Eversole, chairman street committee, to take up matter of parking on Grant street and consider possibility of "No Log Trucks" signs to be placed on Heff Road. Also to take up matter of pedestrian walk on Elm street across railroad tracks from Highway 99-E to First Street.
