

Canby City Council - Regular Meeting March 7th, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Mayor George Irwin at 8:10 PM.

Roll Call: Present, Mayor Irwin
Councilmen, Anderson, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger, Oliver & Stefani.
Sup't Ancel Dunn and Attorney Wade Bettis.

Communications: Letter from attorney Wade Bettis regarding proper procedure for effecting and accepting nominations for City elective offices. His opinion is that such nominations can be accepted either by public caucus meeting or by petition.

Another letter from attorney Bettis was read explaining necessary procedures in placing referendum petition against Ordinance No. 429 on the May primary election ballot.

Claims against City examined by the Council. H. Giger moved seconded by Stefani that claims as presented be allowed and warrants drawn on Treasurer in payment thereof. Roll call vote: Yeas 6 Nays 0. Carried.

A letter from the Electrical Products Company, Portland, was read asking for information about any City code or regulations regarding placing of signs in the City. There being no such code or Ordinance, the Recorder was instructed to write the Bureau of Municipal Research at Eugene to ascertain what information or possible model code they might furnish for the City's consideration.

Recorder was also instructed to obtain from records, minutes and information regarding organization of a caucus committee for the purpose of calling a mass meeting for nomination of candidates for elective City offices for the coming November election.

Report of the Fire Chief and Recorder read and placed on file.

H. Giger moved seconded by Oliver approval of the Rural Fire District negotiating with the City of Barlow for their fire protection. Carried.

Recorder was also asked to ascertain length of time of the ^{Pit}Rural Fire Dep't tax levy. Also write Mr. Victor D. Wolfe about parking Autos on Highway 99-E.

Power charges and equipment for S.R. Smith Co in accordance with schedule 2 of Ordinance 370 were approved by the Council.

Oliver moved seconded by Eversole for the adoption of general specifications for sewer construction as compiled for Sewer District No 4 by Ancel L. Dunn and to be used for future City guidance. Carried.

Mayor Irwin asked wage and hour committee to study applications for Sup't of Public Works and report their findings to the Council.

V. Giger moved seconded by Anderson to maintain the part time positions of office clerk as previously arranged. Motion carried.

Ancel Dunn, Sup't, stated he was agreeable to remaining on the position until the vacancy was filled and to assist in breaking in newly appointed Sup't.
