

Regular meeting Canby City Council  
May 2nd, 1960.

Meeting called to order by Rex Eversole, President of the Council  
at 805 PM.

Roll call: Present, Councilmen, Anderson, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger  
Oliver and Stefani. Sup't Lee Cox and Attorney Wade Bettis.  
Absent: Mayor George Irwin, account illness.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved.

First order of business was made the opening of bids for painting

The recorder presented the matter of inefficient operation of the  
duplicating machine in the office which was purchased as a used  
machine five years ago. By general consent the Council approved  
the purchase of a new machine.

Claims against the City examined by Councilmen. H. Giger moved and  
seconded by Anderson claims for April be allowed and warrants drawn  
on Treasurer in payment thereof. Roll call vote: Yeas 6 Nays 0.

A letter from the Rural Fire District was read, in which they  
recommended a full time fire chief and indicated their approval  
of payment of half the salary. Chairman Eversole appointed H. Giger,  
Oliver and Anderson as a committee to consider and report.

Letter from Engineer Green also read, in which he expressed his  
approval of the proposed ordinance and contract with Mr. Beck  
for immediate and additional water supply for the City.

At this point Chairman Eversole was forced to retire from the  
council chambers due to illness and Fred Stefani was by  
unanimous approval made acting President and Chairman.

Attorney Bettis presented a warranty deed from Earl and Sabina  
Oliver for an extension of 232 feet West on Virginia Ave Street.  
H. Giger moved, Anderson seconded acceptance of this deed. Carried.
