

Council meeting of May 18th, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 7.01 P.M. Roll call; present Mayor Irwin, Councilman Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger, Pond and Stefani. Also present was Att. Pettis and Recorder Lawrence.

The minutes of the previous meeting was read and approved.

Communications; Letters from League of Oregon Cities- State Board of Health- Adrian W. Vaaler & Associates- H.W. Haner & Associates- Stevens & Thompson- and I.O. McKnight was read.


As the above letters were all in relation to hiring a engineering firm for the water program, the council decided to vote for whom they considered the best three of the list of firms for a meeting with the council. The votes were tabulated as follows; Carl Green & Associates 5, John Cunningham & Associates 5, Clark & Groff 4, Cornell, Howland, Hayes and Merryfield 4, Stevens & Thompson 2 and Engineering Div. of P.U.C. 1. It was then decided to have a special meeting with the first named three to discuss possible proposals.

Mayor Irwin then stated there will be a special meeting at 7.30 P.M. on Monday May 25th and the Recorder was instructed to write to these firms asking that a representative to be present at 8 P.M.

H. Giger moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Eversole and motion was carried.
