

Special meeting of May 25th 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 7.40 P.M. Roll call- present Mayor Irwin, Councilmen Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, Pond and Stefani. Also present was Att. Bettis, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

The following engineering representatives appeared, Carl Green of Carl E. Green & Associates, Mr. Clark of Clark & Croff, Mr. Burdin and Mr. Kennedy of John E Cunningham & Associates.

Mayor Irwin then gave a brief outline of the city water problems, and it was decided that the representatives appear in the order of their arrival, with the remaining waiting outside the council chambers, which was in the order of Mr. Green, Mr. Clark, Mr. Burdin and Mr. Kennedy.

After each firm was given a hearing, H. Giger moved that the city hire Carl E. Green & Associates to make the preliminary water survey. Eversole 2nd and the motion was carried.

Recorder was instructed to notify Mr. Green to start survey as soon as possible.

H. Giger moved that the meeting be adjourned. 2nd by Eversole and motion was carried.
