

Meeting of June 1, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8.05 P.M. Roll call- present Councilmen Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger, Pond and Stefani. Also present were Att. Bettis, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

The minutes of the previous meeting and special meeting was read and approved.

Communications; Letters from Carl E. Green, Planning Commission and Clark & Groff was read.

Fred Vocs appeared on behalf of the Junior Chamber of Commerce explaining their program on June 6th. There being no objections, it was approved.

Fred Clemenson appeared with his plat for improvement area.

H. Giger moved that the claims be allowed and checks be drawn on the treasury, 2nd by Stefani. Roll call- 6 ayes, no nays.

Fire Chief Christianson made the Ambulance and Fire Dept reports.

Recorder made the Recorders Court report.

After council discussed and inspected the plat of Fred Clemenson, Beck moved that council accept the Planning Commissions recommendation to accept the Fred Clemenson plat on N.E. Hawthorne. Stefani 2nd and motion was carried.

H. Giger moved that the city apply for Urban Renewal from the League of Oregon Cities. Eversole 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt Dunn is to contact Mr. Westling of the League and ask him to appear before the council at the next meeting to go over the details.

After council thoroughly discussed the present and present hookups on lots not assessed by present sewer districts, it was decided that Supt. Dunn contact property owners in area of Virginia, Ivy and Juniper Sts. for possible petition for sewers in that area.

Recorder asked permission to take his vacation the week of June 22nd. As no objections, Mayor Irwin stated that it was granted.

Recorder asked permission for Att. Bettis to draw up an ordinance relating to retention of city records. Att. Bettis was instructed to do so.


Att. Bettis read Ordinance # 424( relating to increasing minimum water rates) on its 2nd and final reading.


H. Giger moved that Ordinance # 424 be accepted on its 2nd and final reading and be made part of the city records. Beck 2nd. roll call- 6 ayes, no nays.

After discussion on present discrepancy between present water rates and previous ordinance, Beck is to investigate possible amendment of that ordinance.

H. Giger moved that meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Eversole. Motion carried.
