Regular mosting of Sept. 8th, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irvin at 8.pm. Roll call. present were Mayor Irwin, Councilmon Anderson, Eversole, V. Giger, Oliver and Stefani. Also present were Att. Bettle, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

The minutes of the previous meeting and recessed meeting was read and approved.

Communications; Trailer permit request of Edwin Doty. Bids were opened from General Electric and Metorola Co. for communication equipment for Fire Dept. Bid of Metorola Co was \$3365.46 and General Electric Co was \$4102.00 with turn in of old equipment.

Eversole moved that city accept bid of Motorola Co provided that the Canby Rural Fire Dept. goos along. V. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

After council inspected all claims, Eversole moved that the claims be allowed and checks be drawn on the treasury. Roll call- 5 ayes, no mays.

The council then discussed in some detail the new water rate schedule and it was generally felt that the \$2.50 minimum was satisfactory but the overall rate increase was too great.

Fire Chief Christiensen made the Ambulance and Fire Dept. reports.

Recorder Lawrence made the Recorders Court report.

Att. Bettis read a proposed contract from JN Becks attorney for rental of his well. It was agreed that the contract should be modified in some parts and that the finished agreement would be presented at the next meeting.

V. Giger moved that Edwin Doty be granted a six months extension of his trailer permit. Ene by Stefani and motion was carried.

Chairman Stefeni of the Finance Committee stated that the Finance Committee had met to check the Recorders records, but would hold their report until after the Auditors report.

Recorder Lawrence then read a letter, requesting that he be reinstated as office manager of the City Hall. After some disussion, the Mayor was authorized by the Council to meet with the office employees in an effort to straighten up the so called friction.

Att Bottle read the 2nd and final reading of Ordinance # 426. Roll call vote- 5 ayes, no mays.

Eversole moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Anderson and motion was carried.

Meeting adjourned at 10.45 pm.
