

Adjourned Regular meeting Canby City Council  
November 9th, 1959.

Meeting called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8 PM.

Roll call: Present: Mayor Irwin, Councilmen Anderson, Eversole, Oliver & Stefani.

Sup't Dunn, Attorney Wade Bettis.

Absent: Councilmen H. Giger and V. Giger.

Minutes of previous meeting of October 19th and Nov. 2nd read and approved.

Letters from Mr. & Mrs. George Cattley and the City Planning Commission read by the recorder.

Claims against the City examined. Eversole moved all claims as presented be allowed and warrants drawn on Treasurer for payment. Stefani seconded and motion carried by roll call vote - Yeas 4 No None.

Quarterly report of City Treasurer read by Treas. Curt Johnson Jr. Eversole moved report be accepted. Oliver seconded and motion carried.

Sup't Dunn reported two residence building and one residence remodelling permits, 4 water and 1 sewer connections for period Nov 1st to Nov 9th.

Recorder reported 4 traffic citations, forfeited bail \$10.00 and \$22.00 in fines during month of October.

Fire department reported one city and one rural call during October and from Sept 15th to Oct 20th Seventeen ambulance calls and balance in ambulance fund \$723.81.

Sam Amundson addressed the Council pertaining to proposed ordinance #429 on contract with Mr. Beck for city water supply. Mr. Amundson suggested this be referred to the citizens for vote. Mr. Beck presented further maps and plans in explanation of his proposed well and service. Attorney Bettis read a letter he had written to Attorney Frank McCulloch and the reply received to explain in further detail features of the contract dealing with the City and Contractor's liabilities as set forth therein. General discussion of the proposed agreement followed with special interest centering in who would be obligated to pay taxes on the well and the repair bills. Attorney Bettis was asked to ascertain from the County Assessor information concerning the matter of taxes.

Sup't Dunn was instructed to have corner stones replaced on the George Cattley and Paul Wemrick properties and charge expense to the sewer department.

Matter of curbs on Wait Avenue discussed and turned over to Planning Commission.

Council approved the recommendations of the City Planning Commission for the trailer camp proposed by Mr. Al Seida and to proceed with the development in accordance with City ordinances. Recorder instructed to so advise Mr. Seida.

Chairman Oliver reported on pipe line to S.R. Smith Company new plant and the City Park. City to proceed with pipe line construction with the understanding that any property owners connecting later should help pay costs, and requested an ordinance be prepared to cover this feature.

The Hiway Market applied for renewal of their store package beer license. Eversole moved that license be renewed upon payment of proper City license fee. Seconded by Stefani and motion carried.

Attorney Bettis read Ordinance #428 on water service installation charges on second reading. Anderson moved and Eversole Seconded this ordinance be passed on second and final reading. Roll call vote - Yea 4 No 0. Carried.

Oliver moved and Anderson seconded that second and final reading of ordinance #429 be postponed until next regular meeting. Carried.
