

REGULAR MEETING OF JANUARY 19th, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8.02 pm. Roll call- present were Councilmen Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger and Pond. Also present were Att. Bottis, Supt Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of previous meeting and special meeting was read and approved.

Communications; letter from Lonnie Logsdon relating to demolishing his house on So. Ivy.

Treasurer Johnson made his quarterly report.

Beck moved that the treasurers report be accepted subject to audit of Finance Committee. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt. Dunn stated that the Quonset Hut has been hooked up for heaters by Beck Electric, and that Mr. Smith is having an easement drawn up crossing the Clemenson property for his sewer hook up and that Mr. Smith is willing to pay all necessary cost.

Beck moved that Mr. Smith be granted permission to hook up to the sewer provided that he pays the \$50.00 hook up charge and produce satisfactory easement crossing private property. V. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder read Resolution XX relating to authorization of Rex Eversole and Fire Chief Christiansen to purchase surplus property.

H. Giger moved that Resolution XX be adopted. Beck 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt. Dunn made a report of new equipment building regarding cost of plumbing- gutters and doors, and suggested that city could build doors and save expenses.

V. Giger moved to grant Supt. Dunn permission to make new doors for the new equipment building, Pond 2nd and motion was carried.

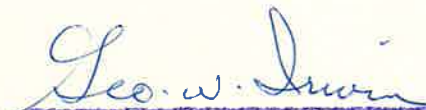
