

REGULAR MEETING OF FEB. 16, 1959.

The meeting was called to order by Mayor Irwin at 8.01 PM. Roll call- present were Mayor Irwin, Councilmen, Beck, Eversole, H. Giger, V. Giger and Stefani. Also present were Att. Bettis, Supt. Dunn and Recorder Lawrence.

Minutes of previous meeting read and approved after one correction noted.

Hugh Harper, Chairman of the Canby Civil Defense and ^{LAWRENCE} ~~Beck~~ Beck appeared on behalf of the Clackamas County Sheriff's Reserves, asking for some financial assistance for equipment. After discussion, they were asked to submit a list of articles they might need, and present it to the next council meeting.

Beck then moved that the Canby Civil Defense be authorized to make application for a jeep ~~for~~ Civil Defense Agency at this time, V. Giger 2nd and motion was carried. *thus*

Recorder read communication from League of Oregon Cities relating to funds advanced in 1958 for urban planning assistance.

H. Giger moved that city ask for return of the \$450.00 and that it be placed back in the depts from which it originally was drawn. Stefani 2nd and motion was carried.

Recorder read communication from Canby Chamber of Commerce relating to excessive charge for electricity during Xmas decoration period.

Supt Dunn explained that there were more lights and were used for a longer period than formerly.

V. Giger moved that the Chamber of Commerce electric bill be discounted by \$25.00. H. Giger 2nd and motion was carried.

Supt Dunn made report of petition for curbs on NE 3rd and stated that Wm. Schaefer is meeting with that group to submit a private bid.

After considerable discussion on water situation, it was decided that the committee is to meet, with a long range program in mind, for a well and additional storage.

Stefani reported that Kraft was agreeable on the Cemetery proposition and would remove trees and stumps and level the ground.


Supt Dunn reported that the water line has been installed on Neff Road at Schunakers property.


Recorder asked Mayor if he desired to have a committee again look into the League of Oregon Cities Hospital plan for employees.

Recorder was instructed to get a contract from the Blue Cross for the council to consider.

Beck moved that the meeting be adjourned, 2nd by Eversole and motion was carried.

Meeting adjourned at 10.50 pm.
