W. Giger moved that the chamber of concerce sidecric sill be discounted by \$29.000. H. figer 2nd and notion was carried.

Supt Dunn made report of petition for curbs on NE 3rd and stated that Wm. Schaefer is meeting with that group to submit a private bid.

After considerable discussion on water situation, it was decided that the committee is to meet, with a long range program in mind, for a well and additional storage.

Stofani reported that Kraft was agreeable on the Cometery proposition and would remove trees and stumps and level the ground.

Supt Dumn reported that the water line has been installed on Neff Road at Schunakers property.

Recorder asked Mayor if he desired to have a committee again look into the League of Gregon Cities Hospital plan for employees. Recorder was instructed to get a contract from the Blue Cross for the council to consider.
